Addendum to the AVDC Curriculum Vitae Format for Applicants for Equine Specialty Advanced Standing Status

For Applicants seeking consideration into AVDC Equine Specialty Advanced Standing Pathway 1-c or 2-c:

Eligibility Requirement for Pathway 1-c:

Veterinarians who can demonstrate **extensive specialty-level training** in the field of **equine veterinary dentistry**.

Eligibility Requirement for Pathway 2-c:

Veterinarians who have been **practicing equine dentistry for more than 10 years** and who now spend most of their professional time in equine dentistry, and who, by **teaching, research, or practice**, have contributed substantially to the development of the specialty, **or have advanced training** in the specialty and have demonstrated competency through teaching, research, or practice in equine dentistry.

In order to objectively evaluate each Application for “Advanced Standing” as an AVDC Equine Candidate via a Curriculum Vitae (AVDC Format) detailed descriptions are needed in the following categories: 1) specialty level training in dentistry, 2) teaching in dentistry, 3) research in dentistry and 4) practice in dentistry. Please pay attention to the description below along with the current AVDC version of how to create a Curriculum Vitae Format. These **Eligibility Requirements** should be described in the Curriculum Vitae as outlined below:

Under Education:

Describe *post doctorate veterinary* Continuing Education and Training in veterinary dentistry. List the Date, Venue, Instructor(s), Training Format, Topic, and Length of Training.

Course Descriptions are required for programs which have not been pre-approved by the AVDC.*

Under **Professional Writings and Media Materials Authored:**

(Teaching)-Reference publications, proceedings, and media material related to dentistry.

Under **Professional Presentations:**

(Teaching) - List presentations related to veterinary dentistry you presented at **professional veterinary venues** (Eg. State VMA Mtg, AAEP, AVMA). List the Date, Sponsoring Organization, Title, Presentation Format, Audience, Audience Size, and Length of Presentation.
